

The budget reconciliation bill has been signed into law. We hope this will ensure high-quality, affordable health care for older Americans and those with disabilities.

All of the harmful and controversial Medicare proposals about which seniors expressed concern were dropped from the final bill, including:

- 1) the co-payment for Medicare home health services
- 2) the age increase for Medicare eligibility and
- 3) the income-related Part B premium.

Your work to protect low-income Medicare beneficiaries from premium increases and to expand preventive health benefits were also successful.
