

## A MESSAGE FROM THE WAYS & MEANS COMMITTEE

Dear AARP member,

As you know, we always need a sound system when we have our AARP meetings. The one at the Community Center is not very reliable. As a thank you to the town for the free use of the Community Center for our meetings and for providing us with a beautiful senior center, the AARP Board has approved our buying a sound system and giving it to the town. But we need your help.

The Chapter has gotten professional assistance to describe a system that would be suitable. It has speakers on the podium and two additional speakers that can be positioned to cover the entire room. Also it can accommodate up to 4 microphones. It will cost about \$2500. The Chapter has enough money to buy the system but using this would deplete all of our reserve. So the plan to finance this system is:

- The Chapter is asking for donations from the members of the Chapter, and
- The Chapter will match from its treasury every donation made by the members.

By using this method, we can thank the town for what it has done for us, we and the town can have a very good sound system and we will still keep some reserve in our treasury for other needs.

We are asking you to either contribute an amount of money or to pledge an amount of money that can be paid over 3 months. We would like to have the system available when our meetings start this fall.
