Report on Fund Drive to Raise Money for PA System

The fund drive has been quite successful with 113 individuals contributing or pledging \$2430 as of May 29. The Chapter has provided a matching fund of \$1250, giving a total amount for the fund drive of \$3680. The PA system, an overhead projector, and a portable screen have been purchased for an expenditure of \$2940. A security cabinet will be purchased for the PA system and the balance remaining will be kept in the account and used for worthwhile projects to be selected in the future.
